Footnotes

HOBBS came out running, looped the field to establish control and tucked along the rail before departing the homestretch, carved the pace, well rated and facing only mild resistance, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, was let out a couple of jumps before arriving at the quarter pole, added to his advantage during the ensuing furlong, maintained a healthy margin to the end, driving. KITTEN'S KID assumed the role of stalker early on the opening bend, did so along the outside while being rated for six furlongs, was asked a response entering the stretch, proved no match but held on well enough to turn back a host of rivals to preserve the place. KEY TO POWER positioned in midpack, raced from between rivals, paused for a stride coming to the quarter pole before proceeding to angle outward, went into the four path before getting straightened away, had a good finish down the center of the course, missing out on place honors. MAGICAL SEASON got carried towards the rail by GAELICO at the start, was guided over to the inside and saved ground until upper stretch, angled out and had the rider lose the whip in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, finished willingly en route to earning the final

major check. GAELICO broke inward leaving the starting gate, taking MAGICAL SEASON along for a short ride, secured the pocket by the end of the homestretch, patiently tracked the winner from there, got called upon for the stretch run and got outfinished. ADIRONDACK DANCER travelled in the three path around the second turn, was asked for run and loomed briefly turning for home, flattened out. COMMITMENT LETTER swung three wide into the backstretch, kept within striking distance in the middle of the field for six furlongs, folded. HEAR THE WORD took the inside route and lacked the necessary stretch response. ROVER off to a sluggish beginning, was never involved. MATTY'S AVENGER saved ground and faltered.
