MARTINI BROTHER was unhurried at the back while three to four wide, advanced after the seventh fence, vied four wide on the final turn, held a short lead over the final furlong, battled gamely to the wire and prevailed under strong urging. BARNSTORMING saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced off heels while off the rail on the third turn, went three wide on the final turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, made a bid coming to the final fence, battled with the winner and missed. EXTRAEXTRAORDINARY was reserved inside on the first three turns, raced off the rail on the final turn and finished willingly for the show. KINGDOM was reserved in the middle of the field while off the inside and lacked the needed kick. DR. SKIP went three wide on the first three turns, made a bid around the eighth fence, vied three wide on the final turn, battled on the even terms with the top two over the final fence then was outfinished. SULWAAN (IRE) raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, saved ground on the other turns, swung out into the stretch and failed to rally. CONSTANT CONTACT (GB) was eager early, disputed the pace on the inside, dropped back a bit before the sixth fence, moved back up around the seventh fence, vied between rivals on the final turn and gave way. FORGOTTEN MAN was a bit eager early, raced on the inside while under restraint, saved ground on all the turns and came up empty. SHARP NUMBERS was eager in the early going, contested the pace on the outside, moved clear before the sixth fence, was challenged again around the seventh fence, vied inside on the final turn and weakened. ALAJMAL raced off the rail on the initial turn, went three on the second and third turns, came under the whip after clearing the eighth fence, went four wide on the final turn and failed to respond. BODIE ISLAND went three to four wide on the first three turns and was through after the eighth fence.
