Footnotes

WHITE ROSE swung three wide into the backstretch, but was back in the two path upon reaching the far turn, remained unhurried for slightly over three-quarters, picked up the pace prior to entering the stretch, got asked for some run after settling into upper stretch and noticeably picked up the pace even more so, altered course a couple of paths approaching the furlong marker for better racing room, maintained the momentum, split rivals a sixteenth later, grabbed away the lead soon afterwards and kicked away, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. CONCISE (GB) kept in the two path for most of the way to the end of the backstretch, was guided over to the rail for the start of the run around the second bend, rode the rail all the way to its end, was under some urging getting angled outward for the commencement of the stretch run, got taken wider a bit more racing through the furlong grounds, picked up speed and was sent through the same opening taken by the winner in the late stages to garner the place. LISVERNANE reserved in the two path, was fanned into the six path by the three-sixteenths pole, displayed good energy down the outside of the course to take the show. DIVINE LUCK underwent a four wide pursuit, crept up on the front runners leaving the midway point on the far turn, sat poised as a serious threat a furlong down the road, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before getting asked for her best, failed to fire appreciably. PRECARIOUS rated two wide while prompting SWEET SHIRLEY MAE, was switched over to a drive after leaving the five-sixteenths pole, challenged for command from between rivals as the field turned for home, forged her way to the slimmest of leads with a furlong to go, but with a slew of opponents in hot pursuit and all with a fighting chance, yielded to the heavy pressure for good about a sixteenth later. DANCE WITH GIO saved ground on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch, had the pacesetter drift on to her lane shortly afterwards, forcing the rider to alter course in an attempt to resume the rally, failed to sustain her run, weakening slightly. SABOULI contently tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, was cued up and vacated the premises in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, angled sharply three wide into the stretch, stayed in contention for the next furlong before flattening out. SWEET SHIRLEY MAE came away well and quickly established control, was rated while setting the pace at or very near the two path until the quarter pole, came under intensified pressure a short distance from that station and was soon asked for a response herself, drifted over to the rail during the initial portion of the stretch drive, got overtaken before reaching the eighth pole, tired

steadily thereafter. GO KITTEN GO three wide around both turns, was through by the quarter pole.
