BUSTER'S DAYDREAM broke alertly, quickly showed on front, set the pace while in hand, drew away when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. SEEKING THE MONEY ducked out leaving the gate, was hustled along early, rallied turning for home and finished well on the rail to get the place. HEAVYWEIGHT CHAMP broke awkwardly, bobbed after the start, was steadied along the inside entering the turn, put in a run on the rail nearing the stretch, came wide for the drive and tired in the final furlong. DRAW PLAY was hustled from the gate, chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. PROUD CITIZEN leapt in the air at the start, was rushed up three wide, chased the pace for a half mile and tired. PEEKSKILL had no response when roused.
