TITLE NINE was rated inside, got through on the hedge in midstretch and drew clear, driving. AMADA showed speed while three wide and dug in gamely through the stretch. BELLES LETTRES was rated along early, rallied four wide and finished gamely outside. ETOUFEE was outrun early, came wide for the drive and was going well late. SILVER CLIPPER raced inside and lacked a rally. SILVER SHINE set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. TAILGATE PARTY raced wide throughout and had no rally. DOCK LEAF was outrun early, came wide and had no rally. SOUNDS FISHY pressed the pace from the outside and tired. STREAM chased outside and tired.
