IRISH ROAD stalked the pace while three wide along the backstretch, edged close while in hand on the turn, accelerated to the front in upper stretch, opened a clear lead in midstretch, continued on the front into deep stretch then was fully extended to hold off JAYAR in the final strides. JAYAR trailed to the turn, circled five wide into the stretch then closed steadily in the middle of the track but could not get up. MISTER DEUX settled along the inside on the backstretch, angled three wide leaving the turn, launched a rally in upper stretch then finished willingly to gain a share. TWO CENTSWORTH moved up between horses to gain a slim early advantage, alternated between horses to the top of the stretch then weakened in the final eighth. RECORD TIDE dueled heads apart along the rail for a half, remained a factor into upper stretch then tired from his early efforts. LOOKING GRAND checked at the start, made a run while five wide to reach contention on the turn then flattened out. POLISH failed to mount a serious rally while between horses.
