Footnotes

FOREVER TOGETHER was taken in hand early, trailed for five furlongs, angled out to launch her bid on the turn, swung five wide in upper stretch and unleashed a powerful late run in the middle of the track to win going away. DYNAFORCE moved up from outside to contest the early pace, pressed the pace in the two path for six furlongs, closed the gap on the turn, surged to the front nearing the furlong marker, led into deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. RUTHERIENNE was outrun for seven furlongs while saving ground, swung out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. VACARE raced in close contention along the inside to the turn, angled out in upper stretch, lodged a bid to threaten in midstretch and weakened. LADY DIGBY saved ground to the turn, swung three wide in upper stretch and rallied mildly. BAYOU'S LASSIE set the pace along the inside, opened a wide gap along the backstretch, continued on the front into midstretch and steadily tired thereafter. WAIT A WHILE settled just off the early pace, raced four wide along the backstretch, made a move from outside to reach contention at the top of the stretch and flattened out. CRIMINOLOGIST raced in traffic between horses on the first turn, settled in midpack for five furlongs, lodged a mild bid along the rail in upper stretch, was in tight in midstretch then gave way. BIT OF WHIMSY raced in traffic while in the middle of the pack on the far turn, closed the gap in upper stretch and tired late. CHESTORIA failed to mount a serious rally while four wide.
