Footnotes

LIGHTHOUSE SOUND settled just off the pace while off the inside, ranged up while two then three wide on the far turn, made a bid coming to the quarter-pole, edged clear under two cracks of a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed whip nearing the furlong marker and held well under continued right hand urging. IRISH LION saved ground on the first turn, moved out while off the pace on the backstretch, was roused while three to four wide on the far

turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. KING TING (IRE) was eager while contesting the early lead on the inside then taken back late on the first turn, continued a bit eager while rated on the inside then settled a bit, waited behind rivals outside the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch, was put to a drive, came between horses near the three-sixteenths pole, pursued the winner into the final furlong and finished willingly but missed the place. BELL BY THE RIDGE bumped lightly with a rival just after the start, raced off the inside on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. SCREENPLAY skimmed the rail nearing the first turn, was reserved on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, shifted off the rail at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. VOTER raced off the rail on the first turn, settled towards the rear while on the outside, was roused while near the inside on the far turn and failed to threaten. DECIPHERING DREAMS went three then two wide on the first turn, stalked the pacesetter on the outside, turned up the pressure on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and gave way. FASTEST MAGICIAN saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused while inside on the far turn, came off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. ROGUE VICTORY went three wide on the first, settled towards the back while on the outside, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to respond then was not urged in the final sixteenth. RED JACK bumped lightly with a rival at the start, dropped to the inside on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, vied inside on the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and stopped then was not urged in the final furlong.
