PRECIOUS METAL towards the rear just off the inside in the two path, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch, was bumped lightly by KEY VICTORY straightening away out to the five path, commenced a rally down the center of the course, kicked home with good late energy to get up on the wire. BEER IS GOOD dueled from the three path, was let out from the two path at the head of the lane, took command at the three-sixteenths inching away to the furlong marker, kept on with good kick but was forced to settle for the place when displaced in the last strides by the aforementioned rival. POSTPONE awkward at the break when appearing to lose his footing in behind, was off a beat slow as a result, raced three wide in close pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, was set down at the head of the lane spinning from the three path for home, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. LORD CHELSIE initially between rivals on the front briefly from the gate, was allowed to settle to track the pace from the two path, came under a drive nearing the head of the stretch, offered up a mild bid in the late stages to just garner the last major share. KEY VICTORY tracked the front from midpack down along the rail, swung three wide for home placed to a drive, shifted straightening away out one path bumping lightly with the eventual winner at that juncture while attempting to secure a clear lane, ran on through the stretch just missing the last major share while being out kicked in the late stages. CORONATION DAY chased the pace from towards the rear three wide throughout and offered no response. TIGER WILLIE off a beat slow, came under hustling from the gate and was never a factor. ALL CLASS dueled inside from the start, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, held the front until the three-sixteenths when displaced, remained in contention until the furlong marker before giving way through the final eighth.
