FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$500 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominess will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 123. TURF: Non-winners of \$45,000 twice on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; such a race, 5 lbs.; \$36,000; or two races on the turf, 7 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a Sweepstake on the dirt; or two races on the dirt allowed 3 lbs.; \$36,000 on the dirt, or a race on the dirt allowed 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt weights will apply. Closed Thursday, July 19, 2012 with 22 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.).

ARTEST was urged along while off the inside, continued off the inside on the turn, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to win going away. DRAGO'S BEST chased the pace on the outside, engaged GENTLEMANS CODE on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, battled with the aforementioned rival into the final sixteenth, got the best of that opponent but failed to hold off the winner. GENTLEMANS CODE set the quick pace, vied inside on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, dueled with DRAGO'S BEST into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to get the show. PARTLY MOCHA settled towards the back of the field, was roused while three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and improved position near the center of the course. CAPETOWN DEVIL was urged along on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. MANLY was urged along on the inside, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out some in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. SINGLE MALT MAC chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, held a good position into the final furlong but weakened. LOVE THOSE BOOTS chased the pace, shifted out leaving the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn, came under an all out drive in upper stretch and tired. RICHMOND COUNTY was restless in the gate then last away, raced under urging at the back of the field, was taken in hand while behind rivals near the seven-sixteenths pole, stayed towards the inside on the turn and failed to rally. FULL came away in good order, settled near the back of the field while on the outside, was taken in hand near the seven-sixteenths pole, came under urging while three wide on the turn and failed to

threaten in a dull effort.
