Footnotes

COACH ROYAL tracked the pace on the outside, was asked outside the quarter-pole, took over in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and

proved best under strong urging. SMOKE TOWN moved in early then was wrestled back along the rail, raced inside while hard held on the first turn, continued hard held on the backstretch while tugging at the bit, came under urging while saving ground on the far turn, shifted off the rail near the quarter-pole, chased the winner in the stretch and was second best. MR ALGEBRA raced off the rail on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while towards the inside on the far turn, advanced into striking range in upper stretch but lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. GRIFFIN ROCK saved ground at the rear on the first turn, lagged near the back, raced inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide late on that bend, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. PROFESSOR PLUM broke through the gate prior to the start, raced near the inside on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and failed to rally. GOLDEN GREELEY saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused leaving the backstretch, moved a bit closer while inside on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. BALLERINO raced inside early on the first turn then came off the rail, settled towards the rear of the spread-out field, shifted three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SHERTZER was last to commence, lingered near the back of the field and never reached contention. OXFORD STREET showed good speed, went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, set the clear pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch and gave way. AMBER COAST was rank while hard held in the early going then reserved on the outside, came under urging while off the rail on the far turn and dropped out. (Rail at 9 Feet)
