SLIVER AND ONIONS strung out four wide on the opening bend, followed the front runners over closer to the rail leaving the backstretch, eventually tucking into the two path, loosely drafted behind KING OF BROADWAY from the top of turn to the five-sixteenths pole under some hand urging, tipped back into the three path at that station and got asked for more run as well, swung into the stretch, fought his way to the front by the eighth pole, kicked away, kept busy to the end. KING OF BROADWAY in a bit at the start bumped with BRABHAM, prompted that rival three wide until a short distance past the half mile pole, was kept to the same task thereafter, but one path closer the inside, got asked for a response and challenged in earnest turning for home, proved powerless to match strides with the top one once that opponent arrived on the scene, but continued onward to win the fight for place honors. BRABHAM took control shortly after making contact with the runner up at the break, took up residence in the two path while being rated on the lead, was guided over to the rail coming to the seven-sixteenths marker, had KING OF BROADWAY range up and increase the pressure significantly a few strides from the quarter pole, was quickly asked for run in response, got overhauled by the top one making his way through the furlong grounds, then got outfinished for second. DYKER BEACH saved ground to the quarter pole, was angled out into the three path before completing the next sixteenth, proved no match for any of the first three finishers. HOWIE'S TIZ on the rail on the far turn, angled off of it spinning into the lane to no avail. MASERATI (BRZ) put three wide at the head of the stretch, trailed.
