FOR THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES OVER A MILE IN 2013. No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$500 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$750 rebate. The first four finishers of the Curlin will have their entry fee waived for the Travers. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over in 2013 allowed 2 lbs., \$47,000 at a mile or over in 2012-13, 4 lbs.; a race at a mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A presentation will be made to the winning owner.

Footnotes

TRANSPARENT came away in good order, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, shifted three wide midway through the far turn, had the rider take a peek behind him then angled five wide outside the quarter-pole, bothered PROUD STRIKE at that point causing him to clip heels, floated out a bit just after turning into the stretch, rallied on the outside, drifted out under a left-handed whip approaching the furlong marker, gained the lead leaving that marker, came in while moving clear at the sixteenth-pole, drifted out again under a left-handed whip late and proved best. ROMANSH stumbled at the start, lost his footing while trying to recover, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four to five wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled three abreast while outside in upper stretch, fought into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while clear for the place. BAD HOMBRE prompted the pace on the inside, drew even with five furlongs to run, vied a bit off the rail on the far turn, dropped to the inside at the quarter-pole, fought inside of a duo into the final furlong then weakened while just able to get the show. EDGE OF REALITY went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn, made a bid outside the five-sixteenths pole, battled between rivals in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong and tired then just missed the show. PROUD STRIKE raced off the rail on the first turn, settled near the back of the compact field, went three early on the far turn then moved to four wide, clipped heels when the winner came out in front of him outside the quarter-pole, stumbled and had the rider lose his left iron for several strides, regained the iron while five to six wide into the stretch and lost all chance. KEG PARTY broke in at the start, settled on the inside, moved up outside the half-mile pole, was urged along while inside on the far turn and came up empty. CERRO (IRE) set the early pace while off the rail, was joined by BAD HOMBRE near the five-eighths pole, continued on the pace while on the outside, vied two to three wide on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch, drifted out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and faded. Following a stewards' inquiry and a claim of foul by the jockey of PROUD STRIKE, TRANSPARENT was disqualified from first and placed fifth for interference near the quarter-pole.
