GRAZE advanced outside on the turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. NIGHT FLIGHT contested the pace from the outside and continued on gamely to earn the place. TOREDOWN rallied four wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely outside. G' MORNING GOVENOR contested the pace and weakened along the inside in the final furlong. COUNTRY BE GOLD came wide nearing the stretch and was going well late from the outside. TIME FOR A DREAM was hustled along early, rallied wide nearing the stretch and had little left for the drive. RETENTION raced wide and had no rally. OLERUD was inside and had no rally. LA SALLE STREET was rushed up after the start, raced greenly while between rivals and tired. PARIS BOUND chased inside and tired. LITTLE WINSTON tired after showing brief speed. DOWNBEAT contested the pace along the inside and tired after a half mile.
