TRANSCENDENTAL raced with the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. SHINY BAND set the pace along the inside and gave way in the stretch. K. C.'S GIFT chased outside and tired. WEEKEND GOLD raced inside and tired. FOR MY PLEASURE was outrun.
