FISHY ADVICE steadied in tight and dropped back soon after the start, trailed along the backstretch, raced well back to the turn, rallied slightly off the rail entering the stretch, altered course to the inside in upper stretch, got through along the rail while making a strong move in deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. PORT CHESTER contested the early pace along the rail, battled heads apart along the inside to the top of the stretch, opened a clear advantage inside the furlong marker, led into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. CHARLEVOIX alternated for the lead from outside for most of the trip and weakened late. BARON VON TAP checked in traffic on the first turn, raced well in hand while saving ground to the far turn, angled five wide while gaining at the top of the stretch then finished evenly. WOOD BE WILLING steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced well back for six furlongs, circled six wide leaving the turn then gained late while altering course to the inside through the stretch. WUTHERING HEIGHTS (JPN) steadied along the rail on the first turn, raced in midpack while between horses to the turn then lacked the needed response when called upon. GUILLAUME TELL (IRE) steadied between going into the first turn, raced up close while three wide along the backstretch, settled in good position to the turn then came up empty in the drive. HIGH OCTANE was never a factor while saving ground. WILD NATURE (GB) chased three wide for five furlongs, angled five wide leaving the turn then faded in the stretch. IVORY COAST failed to mount a serious rally while four wide throughout.
