### Footnotes

FOLKLORE bobbled at the start, was unhurried while racing well back along the backstretch, launched a rally between horses on the turn, altered course between horses to get clear while four wide entering the stretch, closed steadily to challenge in midstretch and edged away under steady urging. FIFTH AVENUE trailed for a half, saved ground advancing into the stretch, rallied along the rail to reach contention in midstretch then altered course to the outside while gaining in deep stretch. TRUART rushed up along the rail, set the pace while being pressure into upper stretch, yielded to the winner inside the furlong marker then weakened late. ADIEU broke a bit slowly, rushed up along the rail, worked her way forward along the rail leaving the turn, moved to the outside for room nearing the furlong marker and lacked a strong closing bid. MY LUCKY FREE pressed the pace from outside for a half and steadily tired thereafter. LITTLE MISS ZIP steadied in traffic along the backstretch, circled six wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. CAJUN MISTRESS chased three wide in the early stages, angled five wide on the turn then faded in the stretch.
