REWRITE settled in good position for a half. closed the gap while three wide leaving the turn then finished strongly from outside to get up in the final strides. HALF HEAVEN pressed the pace in the two path for five furlongs, launched a bid leaving the quarter pole, gained a brief lead in deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. IRON GODDESS sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace into upper stretch, dug in while battling heads apart into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. RAHYS' APPEAL raced in the middle of the pack while four wide, lodged a mild move on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. SYMPHONY OF PSALMS failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. SABELLINA was outrun for five furlongs, came through along the rail rallying in upper stretch, checked and altered course in midstretch and rallied mildly. ARTISTIC EXPRESS failed to mount a serious rally. HOMERETTE steadied after being bumped and pinched back at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. LATITUDE FORTY steadied along the rail on the first turn and never reached contention. FLY TO ME chased three wide, angled in on the turn then gave way late.
