Footnotes

BELLA ATTRICE was reserved for a half, drifted out on the backstretch, made a sharp three wide move to reach contention on the turn, surged to the front nearing the furlong marker and edged clear under steady urging. SONIC SOUND trailed for six furlongs after breaking slowly, circled five wide at the quarter pole and finished strongly in the middle of the track to gain the place. DR. JESS JR was unhurried for a half while racing wide, continued wide on the turn then finished willingly to gain a share. CRAZY CATLADY raced well back for six furlongs, swung four wide between horses entering the stretch and rallied mildly. JUDGE'S PRIDE pressed the early pace from outside, made a move to threaten at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. DOSE OF REALITY bobbed a few strides away from the gate, rushed up to gain a clear early advantage, set the pace inside into midstretch and gave way. WHO IS LADY saved ground throughout and lacked the needed response when called upon. KITTY NIP steadied in traffic on the first turn, angled in along the backstretch, lodged a mild inside move on the turn and flattened out. CRAFTY N P steadied leaving the first turn, was under a firm hold for five furlongs, saved ground to the turn and gave way.
