PROTESTING pressed the pace on the outside, drew even midway through the far turn, was shaken up in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and drew away while ridden out. ALL ABOUT ALEX set the pace on the inside through slow fractions, was challenged midway through the far turn, came under a left-handed whip at the top of the stretch, lost touch with the winner near the furlong marker and proved no match while well clear for the place. SISTER RESISTOR was headstrong while under a snug hold and saving ground on the initial turn, continued in hand on the backstretch, moved out with a half-mile to run, went three wide while under light urging on the far turn and came up empty while best of the rest. SEEKING THE TITLE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came under some encouragement while four wide on the far turn and faltered then pulled up in distress after the race and was vanned off.
