Footnotes

THUNDEROUS G just off the pace initially, made a four wide bid to the leader at the three-eighths, took over command just prior to the quarter pole under a drive, went clear through the stretch kept to task until the final sixteenth when coaxed the rest of the way home under hand urging to the wire. CYTHEREAN brushed the near side stall at the start, made steady progress while lightly urged through the turn, came under full encouragement at the five-sixteenths, got bumped lightly at the eighth pole as JIM JAMM drifted out, matched strides with that rival briefly before prevailing in the battle for place honors while never threatening the top. JIM JAMM midpack tracking the pace inside, came under a spirited ride from the five-sixteenths, spun for home cutting the corner into the lane, drifted off despite off sided stick work from the three-sixteenths to the eighth pole, bumping lightly with the aforementioned rival at the latter station and matching strides battling for the place, couldn't keep pace with that one in the latter stages while well clear for show honors. THE HOOMAN three wide throughout while racing towards the rear in the turn, came under a drive at the quarter pole and passed tired rivals in the lane. BIG RED TALENT sped off while well off the inside down the backstretch, remained three to four wide through the turn, got confronted by the eventual winner at the three-eighths, was set down at the five-sixteenths in response, lost the lead nearing the quarter pole and faltered. EXCITER loosely tracked the front from the inside, raced three wide in the turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, weakened in the stretch. MACHO LIBRE fractious in the gate just prior to the start, was off a beat slow getting away a bit awkward at the start, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths and faded after a half. RUDYARD REWARD four wide throughout, made no impact. THREE HUNDRED saved ground towards the rear and was never a factor.
