Footnotes

FAVOR FACTOR raced off the rail on the first turn, settled nicely in the middle of the field while on the outside, waited patiently while behind a rival near the five-sixteenths, was asked outside the quarter-pole, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then powered clear under steady urging. BALTHAZAR was reluctant to load, broke awkwardly then bumped hard with FOLK SINGER, was reserved at the rear while off the inside, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, angled six wide late on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch, gained on the outside and finished with good energy to get the place at the wire. CANTONIC came off the inside on the first turn, moved up early on the backstretch, prompted the pacesetter on the outside, turned up the pressure on the far turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch, disposed of FOLK SINGER nearing the furlong marker, was quickly challenged by the winner, lost the advantage to that rival and proved no match then lost the place at the wire. INDY SEA settled on the inside, moved up near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. LEAD SINGER settled on the inside, was urged along before the half-mile pole, saved ground into the stretch, advanced closer into the final furlong but lacked the needed response. DEATH STAR went three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch, advanced into the final furlong but also lacked the needed response. KING BALTHASAR went three wide on the first turn, settled in the second flight, raced off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the

quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong, drifted in late and weakened. FOLK SINGER was bumped hard in the hindquarters at the start, recovered quickly then went to the front, set the pace while off the rail, dropped closer to the inside on the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, battled until near the furlong marker then gave way. ETON BLUE dropped to the rail on the first turn, settled towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. BOX OFFICE went three wide on the first turn, settled outside in the second flight, was asked while three wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide late on that bend and came up empty. CRAVING CARATS went three wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was roused while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 9 Feet)
