Footnotes

CLEAR MARGINS, never far back, advanced inside on the turn, came wide and split rivals entering the stretch then wore down LAKE HURON in the final yards. LAKE HURON prompted the pace from the outside, earned a short lead on the turn and dug in gamely along the inside through the stretch but could not hold off the winner. WOLLASTON'S BABY raced close up 3 wide while in hand, put in a run to reach even terms in midstretch then weakened in the final furlong. MINKABLE, outrun early, circled six wide into the stretch and finished well from the far outside. JAMETTA, hustled along early, raced four wide and lacked a rally. MODEL'S BIG FOUR, rushed inside, tired after showing brief speed. MY LUCKY BABY stumbled at the start and raced four wide. SUMINTRA RENE chased the pace on the rail and tired. EPEEIST stopped after a half mile.
