MAGICALMYSTERYCAT flashed good speed from the outside, gained a short lead turning for home, dug in resolutely in the stretch and prevailed under a steady drive. CIRCLE OF LIFE, close up early, put in a three wide run approaching the stretch and continued on gamely from the outside and got the nod for the place award. REGALLY APPEALING showed good speed along the rail and dug in gamely on the rail through the stretch. FINDER'S FEE, hustled along early, came wide for the drive and finished well from the outside. SILK SAILS, outrun early, came wide into the stretch but had no response when roused. CECILIA'S CROWN, outrun early, put in an inside run on the turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. GILDED DIABLO chased the pace on the rail and tired badly in the stretch.
