RED BULLET raced close up early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, drew clear and remained clear under a drive. VALIANT HALORY contested the pace while three wide and finished gamely outside to earn the place award. FLAMING WEST was unhurried early, raced inside and finished gamely on the rail. FIRE THUNDER raced wide throughout and lacked a rally. PORT HERMAN contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. PANNER was hustled along outside, raced wide and had no response when roused. SAINT JOSEPH raced inside and had no rally. BLUE SNAKE contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
