CABO SUNRISE stalked the early pace while three wide, made a run to challenge at the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in midstretch then drew off under steady urging. DISRUPT forced the pace between horses into upper stretch but was no match for the winner. SAPODILLA was outrun early while saving ground, swung wide in upper stretch and failed to threaten while improving her position. LAKE WEST raced well back while four wide into upper stretch and passed mostly tiring rivals. FANTASTIC CITY raced up close along the inside for a half and lacked a strong closing bid. DESERT GIRL duelled along the rail to the top of the stretch and faltered. EVENING MIST was never a factor after breaking slowly. FIAAFY faded after going a half.
