CLASSIC ELEGANCE was hustled from the gate but dropped back along the inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, responded when roused, finished determinedly and was along in time outside. ANGEL TRUMPET was hustled to the front, set the pace, drew clear into the stretch, widened when roused and was caught nearing the finish. WILD CHICK was hustled outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and had little left for the stretch drive. DARN THAT GIRL was hustled along outside, chased the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. BROADWAY GOLD was outrun early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and had nothing left for the drive. DRESSED FOR SUCCES chased the pace from the outside and tired after a half mile. PARTNERS DUE chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. LADY DYNASTY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. COCONUT POPSICLE had no response when roused. PELHAM BAY raced inside and tired.
