ZOSOGOOD bumped lightly with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, engaged the leader while three wide on the turn, edged clear outside the furlong marker and held sway under strong urging. READING GROUP raced towards the rear while reserved, was hard held while in traffic on the turn, lacked room behind rivals in upper stretch, moved in near the furlong marker and closed well but missed. HITTIN THE NOTE moved up on the inside, waited patiently while near the rail on the turn, came out outside the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. FORTUNATE RUN settled towards the outside, chased four wide on the turn and also weakened. STEAL THE SHOT was in a bit tight near the half-mile pole, raced two to three wide on the turn and came up empty. GAME TOKEN bumped lightly with a rival at the start, dropped to the rear, raced three then two wide on the turn and failed to respond. HEAVENLY BLAZE was rated just off the pace, raced under a very tight hold while in tight from the half-mile pole to the seven-sixteenths pole, went three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and had nothing left. JUSTIN P was last away then ridden along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor then pulled up in distress after the race and was vanned off. BRIDLEDWAY set the pace, vied a bit off the rail on the turn, lost the lead nearing the quarter-pole and faded.
