Footnotes

ESSEX FERRY was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, raced just off the pace, ranged up while three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch and inched clear under good handling. SUDDEN SILVER contested the pace on the outside, vied outside on the turn, battled with the winner into the final furlong then was outfinished while clear for the place. WON TOKEN broke outward and bumped lightly with ESSEX FERRY, raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was along for the show. MONEY CHARGER settled on the outside, jostled with rivals leaving the backstretch, advanced four wide on the turn but came up empty. GREENS N BEANS brushed the gate at the start, chased the leaders from third, raced off the rail on the turn and tired. LA BELLE GABRIELLE broke a bit slow, moved out outside the half-mile pole, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. GREAT CLIFF contested the pace on the inside, vied inside on the turn and gave way then had the rider lose his whip near the sixteenth-pole. SILVER TAX was urged along in the middle of the field, came out a bit and brushed with MONEY CHARGER leaving the backstretch, raced

three wide on the turn and had nothing left. A GIRL NAMED MARIA settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. HUNNY OF A TOUR jostled with a rival leaving the backstretch and was forced five wide, dropped to three to four wide shortly thereafter, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. OUR LADY LIBERTY raced well back in the field, was in tight near the three-eighths pole, raced three to four wide on the turn and was no factor.
