Footnotes

CROWNED GENERAL showed good speed from the gate, prompted the pace on the inside, waited patiently while saving ground on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under measured urging. CAYO HUESO showed good speed and set the pace, inched clear leaving the backstretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while just able to get the place. KING ROCK raced just off the pace on the inside while under a hold, was in tight off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out at the top of the stretch and closed well but missed. CORONATION DAY dropped back at the start, was urged along at the back, saved ground early on the turn, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out in upper stretch and finished fast but was too late. DON'T FOOLI HOULI dropped back after the start, was urged along near the back, raced off the rail early on the turn, dropped in near the five-sixteenths pole and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick. FLATTER THAN ME was rated between rivals, raced two then three wide on the turn and came up empty. DUNVEGAN was rated just off the pace on the outside, came under some urging on the turn, held a good striking position into upper stretch but came up empty and gave way. LITTLE ALEX raced just off the pace, was in tight off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, went three then four wide on the turn and dropped out. (Rail at 12 Feet)
