Footnotes

MOON STRUCK NEMI settled along the inside shortly after the start, was unhurried for most of the run around the bend, picked up the pace the nearing the quarter pole, rallied into contention while still hugging the inside during the initial portion of the stretch drive, vacated the premises in the vicinity of the eighth

pole, lost none of her momentum after completing the maneuver, charged past the runner up with a sixteenth to go and kicked clear. WATKINS GLEN got off to a good running start to quickly assume the lead, set the pace, from the inside, and with the rider applying a firm hold until the quarter pole, was still in possession of a clear advantage leaving the eighth pole, wasn't able to match speed with the top one arriving at the sixteenth pole, giving in readily to that opponent's challenge, dug in well to preserve place honors. JAZZ LIFE (BRZ) worked out a tuck along the rail in time for the run around the bend, slipped outward just before reaching the quarter pole, swung to be three wide at the head of the stretch and took off in earnest, finished willingly to be along for the show. ELLE SPECIAL was placed in the three path at the five-sixteenths pole, gearing up for the stretch drive, settled eventually to be six wide at the head of the stretch after completing the search for optimal racing clearance, rallied mildly for the last major award. GRACE AND COURAGE disputed the pace from the two path, was asked for some run to keep pace late on the turn, backed away after entering the stretch. MS. LYDIAN was taken in hand after being in a tight behind the top one soon after the start, made up some ground during the opening stages of the stretch run, flattened out. S'HAZEPLAYINFORME angled four wide into the stretch, had no rally. SPA SUNRISE gave chase from the outside, was in a full drive by the five-sixteenths pole, gave way. SILVER OVER GOLD raced along the outside, was urged on the turn, and folded. OVERSEAS MARKET came outward after lunging at the start, was grabbed hold and put back on course, left the backstretch three wide, remained a forward factor for a half then tired.
