BEST ACT sat reserved off the inside for nearly three-quarters, picked up the pace coming to the quarter pole, spun wide into the stretch, commencing to rally in earnest from the five path, gained readily during the run through the furlong grounds, collared the leader in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, beating DODGING to the punch, and edged away under good handling. DODGING sat within range along the outside, was asked for some run prior to angling four wide into upper stretch, worked his way into contention during the initial portion of the stretch drive, continued on willingly during the last eighth to take the place. COUSIN RICH off to an alert beginning, displayed good early speed, en route to establishing an open lead, was placed slightly off the inside with the rider atop with a good hold on the reins, cutting the early fractions, continued along on the same scenario for almost six furlongs, was let out at the quarter pole, responding to intensified pressure coming from the nearest pursuers, still held a comfortable advantage at the eighth pole, proved powerless to stave off the top one, relinquishing readily with about a sixteenth remaining, weakened steadily thereafter into the show slot. GO TO THE NET bumped with MORENO STAR just out of the starting gate, advanced willingly to take up a forward position, contently tracked the pacesetter towards the two path, continued to bide time during the run around the far turn, swung into the stretch and got called upon, failed to muster up the needed response. BUNDESTAG (GB) came inward departing the gate, brushing into the barrier's left side, appeared none of the worse for wear after the incident, tucking along rail soon afterwards, saved ground thereafter, made a mild rail run during the early portion of the stretch drive, but soon flattened out. SHOUTOUT sped past the field leaving the gate to take up the role of stalker, loosely attended the pace from the outside throughout the opening three-quarters, attempted to apply some pressure on the leader three wide at the quarter pole, but wasn't up to the task. MORENO STAR was bumped after the start, raced

along the outside, failed to respond when asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole. MYSTICAL TERP bobbed after the start, failed to reach a contending position. DALLAGLIO was never involved. ALVITO strung out in the three path on the opening bend, continued off the inside throughout, was already under encouragement coming to midpoint on the far turn, folded.
