STAKES Quick Call S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any point prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominess will receive a \$750 rebate.

The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. Weight 123.

TURF: Non-winners of \$45,000 twice on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; such a race, 5 lbs.; \$36,000; or two races on the turf, 7 lbs. DIRT:

Non-winners of a Sweepstake on the dirt; or two races on the dirt allowed 3 lbs.; \$36,000, or a race on the dirt allowed 5 lbs.

(Maiden, claiming and restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt allowance weights will apply. Closed Friday, July 22, 2011 with 22 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.).

Footnotes

GREAT MILLS stumbled at the start but recovered quickly, was never far back, ranged up while three wide on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, made a bid under left hand urging in upper stretch, dueled with FUDGESICLE in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under mostly hand urging. FUDGESICLE showed good speed from the outside post, crossed over and set the pace, controlled the action while inside on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the eighth-pole, dueled with GREAT MILLS in the final furlong and just missed. BUG JUICE was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. NUTMEGCUVEEROYALE brushed with a rival at the start, showed speed on the inside, was shuffled back near the half-mile pole, raced inside while ridden along on the turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick then pulled up in distress after the wire and was vanned off. LONGHUNTER (GB) was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. FASTEST MAGICIAN brushed with a rival at the start, was reserved at the rear of the field, raced under a snug hold leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, was put to a drive and also lacked the needed response. SHMOOZ TALKER settled on the outside, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. ROYAL CURRIER tracked the pace, steadied when GREAT MILLS came in a tad near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch then tired.
