LAWN MAN broke well and quickly made it to the lead, was taken inward, eventually settling just off the rail, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead, was put to encouragement a few strides before reaching the quarter pole, kicked away from the competition during the ensuing furlong, added to the winning margin, kept busy to the end. PASS THE PICO sneaked his way into the pocket just before reaching the end of the backstretch, tracked the winner from there, was angled towards the middle of the strip during the initial portion of the stretch drive in two stages, failed to keep pace with the top one, battled with another pair for the place honors, got bumped just near the end while gaining it. HONORABLE DILLON rode the rail in the initial stages, was already urged taking the four path for entrance into the stretch, hooked up with two others while proceeding his way down the lane, was bumped late while losing out on the place photo. TIZRACER chased the winner from the outside, began to fall back approaching the quarter pole, came out near the finish line after the second of two left handed shots, bumping with the runner up and carrying that one out enough to initiate contact with HONORABLE DILLON. NEW LINE along the outside for much of the opening half, ducked inward and cut the corner into the lane, had no rally. INDYGOLYER raced along the outside on the turn, felt the whip by the midway point on the turn, failed to get motivated and tired. NORTH SLOPE brushed with SIMON EYES just out of the starting gate, was hustled afterwards to secure a forward post, chased the front runners from off the inside, gave way after going a half. SIMON EYES bobbed awkwardly at the start before bumping lightly with NORTH SLOPE, departed the backstretch from the three path and was never in contention.
