**Footnotes**

WINNING CAUSE bobbled slightly at the start and traded light bumps with BELLARMINE for a few steps away from the gate, settled three to four wide towards the rear after saving ground through the first turn, came under encouragement nearing the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the quarter pole, shifted out a path straightened away, rallied with a good kick to confront JOHA inside the final sixteenth, fought briefly head to head before inching away from the rival in the last jumps to prevail. JOHA on the pace in hand inside attended from the outside, came under light coaxing at the five-sixteenths before being roused cutting the corner into the stretch as the pressure intensified, inched away under a drive a furlong out, dug in confronted a sixteenth from home, fought briefly head to head with the aforementioned rival before capitulating in the final strides while safe for the place. ONE MORE CAT eased back to track the pace inside, got angled out a path and put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, continued the angle to be three wide turning for home, offered up a mild kick digging in in tandem with BELLARMINE through the final eighth to just garner the show. BELLARMINE traded light bumps at the start with WINNING CAUSE who was recovering his footing, was briefly steadied in a bit tight entering the first turn as rivals crossed in front, got put to light coaxing two to three wide in mid pack before spirited up three furlongs from home, offered up a mild kick in a drive through the lane and was just denied the show honors. HAMP firmly held early on off heels a bit rank and stargazing into the first turn, settled just off the inside towards the rear, was steadied briefly at the three-eighths in tight as BELLARMINE shifted to the rail, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, angled out to the five path completing the move a furlong out and made no late headway while kicking on mildly to the wire. ELUSIVE SON attended the pace maker from just off the inside, raised the pressure on that rival when placed to a drive at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside into the lane, kept on to the three-sixteenths, then weakened in the drive. PLAY IT LOUD unhurried early on, raced three wide through the first turn, ranged up to take closer order down the backside, came under coaxing three furlongs out, began to fade nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide at that station and weakened in the stretch. FLYING BIRD pinched back lightly between foes when unable to keep pace from the gate, settled two to three wide at the rear, got shaken up at the three-eighths pole and trailed throughout.
