**Footnotes**

BARRISTER JIM jostled with an opponent after the start, went to the front into the first turn, came a bit off the inside on that bend, set the pace through solid fractions while off the rail, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, wandered a bit to the outside at the top of the stretch then was straightened with a pull of the left-rein, drifted out under left-handed pressure near the eighth-pole, came back in when switched to a right-handed whip, went back to a left-handed whip while near the rail about the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under strong handling. SO OUTSPOKEN came in at the start, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, floated four wide into the stretch, drifted out under a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, was switched to a right-handed whip, drifted back in near the sixteenth-pole and was clearly second best. GREAT CALL jostled with rivals after the start then was asked, raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, was well placed behind the pacesetter, chased inside on the far turn and tired while able to get the show. NAVAJO CA LO was caught five wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, raced towards the rear while urged along on the backstretch, started the far turn in the two path, angled four wide approaching the five-sixteenths, moved to five wide at the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. PLAUSIBLY bobbled at the start then jostled with GREAT CALL, was reserved while inside on the first turn, settled on the backstretch, came under urging near the half-mile pole, saved ground while ridden along on the far turn and was no factor. LET THE CAT OUT went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged by the half-mile pole, went three wide while hard ridden on the far turn and failed to respond. PRINCE CURLIN went four then five wide on the first turn, dropped well behind and faltered.
