Footnotes

NORUMBEGA brushed with KID SIDNEY a few strides after the start, was strung out three to four wide on the opening bend, fanned onto the overland route entering the backstretch and remained the widest of all proceeding towards the half mile pole, ranged up gradually from the four path leaving that station, maintained the momentum after getting set down turning for home, advanced steadily on the front runners, made light contact with the show horse after that rival was carried out slightly from pressure originating from the inside near the sixteenth pole remained under encouragement during and after the incident, forged on ahead to take over in the final seventy yards and kicked clear. TIZ ADONIS bumped several times with KID SIDNEY in the very earliest stages, raced three wide around each bend, although one path wider down the backstretch, moved together with MIDNIGHT TABOO to confront the pacesetter leaving the backstretch, entered the stretch under a drive, arrived at the furlong marker with a narrow advantage, but with a pair in hot pursuit, drifted outward under some left handed stick work approaching the sixteenth pole, herding out KID SIDNEY towards the winner, with all three eventually making contact, got overtaken soon afterwards, then reached the wire in time to preserve the place. KID SIDNEY suffered through a series of light bumps from both sides shortly after the start, sat reserved from off the inside for the opening half, swung four wide into the stretch and took off in earnest after the front runners, was battling between rivals for command when herded out slightly by the runner up, making light contact with both while tightly wedged in between them with a sixteenth to, mustered up a strong late burst of speed during the late stages that narrowly fell short of second. MIDNIGHT TABOO bobbed at the start, rode the rail heading for the opening turn, but swung three wide leaving it, was taken in hand when CARY STREET drifted over into his path at the midway point, unleashed a run from the two path departing the backstretch, with the runner up in tow directly to the outside, fought for the lead from between rivals for about another eighth, ducked over to the rail and the cut the corner into the lane under a drive, vied with vigor to the furlong marker before steadily backing away. CAP THE MOMENT made light contact with TIZ NOW MY CHOICE at the start, showed the way from the rail to the half mile pole, got angled outward entering the stretch, came up empty. TIZ NOW MY CHOICE brushed with the breaker to his left at the start, raced in midpack from off the inside, was three wide entering the far and four wide exiting it, had no rally. CARY STREET launched a three wide run to take up the role of primary pursuer, moved past the leader and was sent over to the rail once sufficiently in the clear departing the backstretch, got pounced upon by a twosome a furlong later, yielded before reaching the top of the lane and gave way.
