CALL NINE ONE ONE, unhurried outside early on, advanced four wide leaving the backstretch, came five wide into the stretch, quickly drew clear and was kept busy to remain clear to the finish. EZE, steadied along inside, was caught in traffic much of the journey and finished fast once clear. RUTHIAN, close up early, rallied three wide on the second turn and stayed on well to the finish. MOORLAND MISS raced close up outside and finished with good interest. FOUNT, rated along between rivals, rallied on the second turn and finished well. OJO CALIENTE, outrun early, came wide for the drive but lacked a solid finishing kick. PEG'S PUFFIN raced close up inside and was blocked along the inside through the stretch. KALIDASA quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand and tired in the stretch. SISTER JONES prompted the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. SONG FOR ANNIE, steadied repeatedly inside, had traffic problems on the second turn then was forced to take up in the stretch. SHEBAKAYSKITTYCAT, outrun early, came wide into the stretch but had no rally. COUNTUS AFFAIR raced wide and tired.
