Footnotes

AFLEET ALEX was unhurried while racing well off the rail along the backstretch, rapidly gained while circling five wide on the turn, charged to the front in upper stretch then drew off with authority under steady right hand encouragement. FLAMENCO raced up close early between horses, dropped back a bit on the turn then battled back through the stretch to gain the place. CONSOLIDATOR stalked the leaders while four wide for a half and closed late from outside to gain a share. WINNING EXPRESSION pressed the pace in the two path to the far turn, gained a slim lead on the turn then weakened from his early efforts. DEPARTING NOW raced just off the pace while saving ground, made a run along the rail to threaten in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. LUNARPAL set or forced the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch and tired. SMOKESCREEN was outrun for a half after breaking awkwardly and failed to menace thereafter. CALYPSO BAND failed to mount a serious rally while between rivals. MAXIMUS C was outrun early, rallied mildly while five wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. GOLD JOY bumped at the start, was never a factor. FIRE PATH broke inward bumping with GOLD JOY at the start and was never close thereafter.
