COSMONAUT pressed the pace from outside to the top of the stretch, made a run to challenge in midstretch then edged clear in the final twenty yards. BRIGADIER BROOKS settled in good position for six furlongs, angled four wide to launch his bid leaving the turn, closed the gap to threaten in midstretch but couldn't stay with the winner while outfinishing TIVERTON for the place. TIVERTON sprinted clear from his inside post, raced uncontested on the lead while saving ground to the turn, battled heads apart into midstretch then yielded grudgingly. MY BALLET raced in the middle of the pack to the far turn, circled five wide into the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. DODGER TOWN hit the side of the gate then stumbled at the start, raced up close along the inside into upper stretch and finished evenly. SEVEN TUNES never reached contention. MISWAKI'S BEST failed to mount a serious rally while five wide. LION CAT trailed for most of the way while four wide. WE ALL WIN checked briefly on the first turn and was never close thereafter.
