Footnotes

HESANOLDSALT broke inward a bit at the start, rushed up to contest the early pace, pressed the pace from outside along the backstretch, made a run to challenge leaving the turn, battled heads apart with TAKE THE BLUFF in upper stretch, brushed with that rival while battling into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. TAKE THE BLUFF took the lead soon after the start, set the pressure under pressure to the top of the stretch, dug in when challenged in upper stretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. CORINTHIAN was taken to the outside on the first turn, stalked the leaders while three wide along the backstretch, remained a factor while racing up close for seven furlongs, was asked for run from outside leaving the turn and lacked the needed response when called upon. SIR HALORY hard held through the opening half mile, settled along the inside on the backstretch, angled out entering the stretch and finished evenly. SCIPION broke slowly, never reached contention while trailing most of the trip. WHEN THE SAINTS was pinched back a bit at the start then carried four wide on the first turn, tucked in while hard held along the backstretch and failed to mount a serious rally then was eased late.
