WESTOVER WILDCAT pressed the pace three wide, shook loose in upper stretch and edged away under right hand urging. NO TRUTH TOLD was reserved early, split horses on the turn and finished well to best the others. ANTENNA was outrun for a half, swung six wide and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track to narrowly gain a share. DEVONSHIRE raced a bit greenly well back for a half, swung wide at the quarter pole and rallied between horses while edged by ANTENNA for third. TRAPPE SHOT stumbled at the start, steadied in traffic on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. D'BIGCAT dueled along the rail to the turn and tired. V SAT pressed the pace between horses for a half and gave way. WILDCAT NATION steadied along the inside at the half mile pole, saved ground to the turn and lacked a late response. STEADY EDDIE raced wide throughout. MACJOEY steadied while racing greenly on the far turn and was never close thereafter. DOUBLES PARTNER was outrun after breaking slowly.
