Footnotes

D'BIGCAT was a bit reluctant to load, bumped with a rival at the start, showed good speed on the outside, moved clear outside the half-mile pole, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held well under intermittent left hand urging. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, battled determinedly with FIRE THE BULLET for the place and narrowly earned that spot while unable to threaten the winner. FIRE THE BULLET moved out near the five-eighths pole, was urged along in third, came under a vigorous ride while three wide on the turn, battled with DANCE FLOOR MANIAC for the place and just missed while clear for the show. ROTTEN TO THE CORE bumped with a rival just after the start, was urged along while off the pace, saved ground early on the turn, moved off the rail near the three-eighths pole, continued off the rail into the stretch and failed to rally. TIMBER CAT was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. REDWOOD FEVER was urged along on the outside, advanced three wide on the turn and also came up empty. AWESOME PREACHER bumped with a rival after the start, settled near the back of the field, raced three then four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. UNIQUE ALLY was away awkwardly, showed good speed then chased the leader, saved ground on the turn and tired. ALL WEST broke a bit slow then was taken up off heels, raced at the rear of the field while off the rail, drifted out near the furlong marker and was no factor. PRINCE CODY bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along towards the back,

raced two to three wide on the turn and failed to respond.
