Footnotes

MORENO'S MON pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, was asked passing the quarter-pole, bumped with NATALIE VICTORIA outside the eighth-pole, dueled between rivals into the final sixteenth and gamely prevailed under strong urging. NATALIE VICTORIA went three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, came under some urging while three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, bumped with MORENO'S MON outside the eighth-pole, dueled outside in the final furlong and just missed. CASA TUA set the pace along the rail through moderate fractions, was asked near the quarter-pole, drifted out slightly in upper stretch, battled determinedly into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to secure the show. ITSABEAUTIFULTHING was rank nearing the first turn then reserved on the inside, came off the rail and was asked outside the quarter-pole, moved out once straightened for the drive and finished willingly near the center of the course. THUNDER LILLY raced four wide early on the first turn then tucked into the two path, was rated just off the pace, bided her time while between rivals on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. SORTILEGE was rated on the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. MIRACULUM was taken in hand after the start, raced five wide then four wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide by the three-quarter pole, was reserved on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. ROSES FOR THE STAR went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was

asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. DIXIE SHOES broke inward at the start, settled while off the rail, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole and also failed to rally. (Rail at 9 Feet)
