FOR THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES OVER A MILE IN 2011. No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any point prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs., such a race since then, 4 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 23, 2011 with 29 Nominations.

### Footnotes

TURBO COMPRESSOR broke running and angled over sharply to the rail, was placed under a firm hold, set the splits, loosely contested down the backstretch, left the half mile pole and was given some rein, held at bay a pair of more energetically urged rivals nearing the end of the run around the far turn, turned for home still holding a clear advantage and was set down, increased the margin during the ensuing furlong and safely maintained it, driving. RAISON D'ETAT stalked the pacesetter three wide, was asked for some run prior to issuing an abbreviated challenge for the lead coming to the five-sixteenths pole, took over the two path from a weakening BOLD WARRIOR at that point, was successfully shaken off nearing the head of the stretch, shied from the whip twice in the lane, initially from left handed pressure in the vicinity of the eighth pole, then subsequently from stick work from the opposite side a sixteenth later, continued on willingly to be second best. PRIME CUT saved ground and proved no match for the top twosome. POINT OF ENTRY three wide around both turns, was asked for a response midpoint on the second turn, came up empty. GOLDEN GULCH raced along the outside, was put to encouragement down the backstretch, failed to reach a contending position. BOLD WARRIOR repositioned in the gate prior to the start, became skittish, came away in good order once the starting gate was sprung open, appeared a bit unsettled when taken hold as the top one took control soon afterwards, acted more professionally thereafter, was coaxed along loosely stalking the pacesetter from the two path, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, crept up to the leader when asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, quickly backed away and steadily tired thereafter.
