JUNIOR OFFICER was hustled from the start, chased the pace, made a bid outside the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for his best in upper stretch, battled gamely along the rail in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. NAMRON settled just off the pace while on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn, was asked while five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, made a bid inside the furlong marker, battled three abreast late and just missed in a game effort. MINESCAPE chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled while under the whip in upper stretch, fought gamely between rivals in the final furlong and just missed in a three-way photo. ACADIAN BLUES was urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, gained ground in upper stretch, loomed a threat between rivals entering the final furlong but was outfinished. VEE ONE ROTATE bumped lightly with a rival at the start then was crowded a bit, settled off the pace, was

urged along while two then three wide on the turn, moved out some in upper stretch and finished willingly. POLICE CHATTER settled just off the pace while on the inside, drafted nicely behind the leader on the turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, brushed with HEY CUZ while blocked in upper stretch, was urged along behind rivals into the final furlong, continued under urging while still behind foes and lacked the needed kick. MANX was restless in the gate, lacked early speed, raced inside on the turn and was no factor. HEY CUZ brushed with a rival at the start then came out and bumped with MYHORSEOFCOURSE, had that rival clip his heels, moved up to take the lead, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, brushed with POLICE CHATTER while dropping back in upper stretch and gave way. MYHORSEOFCOURSE was bounced around between rivals at the start then clipped heels, had the rider lose his right iron, regained the iron in the vicinity of the three-quarter pole, raced well behind and was no factor. IMPERIAL ROBYN was restless in the gate, came away in good order, was well placed just off the pace, dropped back while off the rail on the turn and came up empty then was not urged in the final furlong.
