Footnotes

THE WEST RIM secured the pocket before reaching the first turn, contently tracked the pacesetter under a good hold from the rider for over three-quarters,. was let out a notch and angled outward approaching the quarter pole, gearing up for the stretch, took off in earnest after the leader, after settling in, made up ground readily from upper to midstretch, continued onward, wrested away the lead and kicked clear under good handling. PROUDROAD TO GLORY three wide until the three-eighths pole, finished with good energy to garner the place. PRINCESS MAURA off to an alert start, grabbed the lead and was sent over towards the rail, showed the way from there, being rated by the rider, felt some pressure late on the far turn and was soon asked for run in response, held her ground well during the ensuing furlong, got reeled in by the winner soon afterwards and steadily weakened into the show slot. IN HER HEY DAY off the inside, made up some ground during the initial portion of the stretch run before flattening out. BLUE GRASS MUSIC swung four wide entering the backstretch, was widest of all making her way towards the half mile pole, worked out a tuck into the three path at that station, was asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. KITTYLICIOUS three wide entering the second turn, was five wide exiting it, failed to make any headway on the front runners. NURSE DOLCE brushed from between rivals at the start, was taken in hand when caught in tight quarters amongst opponents during the early stages, raced from off the inside and failed to reach a contending position. SASTA GO LUCKY saved ground to no avail. TUTTI VA BENE made light contact with NURSE DOLCE leaving the starting gate, checked while in tight along the rail during the run along the homestretch, saved ground until the quarter pole, came up empty for the stretch drive, then was vanned off after crossing the wire. JARDENIA made a three wide to take up the role of stalker, remained a forward factor for nearly three-quarters before backing away. PURELY MAJESTIC off to a sluggish beginning, raced from off the inside, was placed five wide for the start of the stretch drive, had nothing to offer. PLEASANTFRIDAY three wide around both turns, was through after completing six furlongs.
