DON DULCE sat within range of the front runners from off the inside, entered the far turn with the tempo quickening quite noticeably, left the midway point having been put to heavy rousing, spun three wide and resumed the chase in earnest, got hooked up a spirited tussle with the second place finisher for much of the final sixteenth pole and gamely got the head down in time at the wire to prove best. AUSSI AUSTIN assumed the role of primary pursuer well before reaching the end of the homestretch, contently kept an eye on the leader, parked out in the two path, moved up to latch on more fully as the third fraction, much sharper than the previous two, was being recorded, poked a head down in front by the quarter pole to lead the field into the stretch, scampered away to his biggest advantage from upper to midstretch, had the top one chop it steadily until directly alongside in the late stages, went at it head to the head resolutely only to come up on the short end of the win photo. CEASE at or near the inside to the top of the lane, got angled outward at that juncture, mustered up a mild response to grab the show award. TECH FALL took the inside route, was already being asked for run by the three-eighths pole, swung outward eventually settling into the five path by the three-sixteenths marker, went on to mainly improve position. BIG SCREEN was pulling gently on the bit gradually getting guided over to the rail, was rated on the front end while showing the way, picked up speed departing the backstretch, but had the runner up increase his presence nevertheless, fell back by a sliver by quarter pole, stayed in contention for an additional furlong before backing away. FLASHY SUNRISE three wide on each bend, was under encouragement on the second one, folded.
