MIDDLESEX DRIVE showed in front soon after the start, set the pace along the hedge, dug in determinedly when set down for the drive and prevailed under steady pressure. TANGAZI, close up early while well in hand, rallied three wide on the second turn and finished gamely but could not get by the winner. COMIC STRIP, rated along outside, rallied four wide on the final turn and finished gamely from the outside. JOHN'S CALL, wrapped up on the hedge, saved ground, got through inside, angled out and finished gamely. SPECIAL MOMENTS, outrun early, was checked on the second turn, got through on the hedge but lacked a rally. DIVIDE AND CONQUER raced three wide and had no response when roused. ABORIGINAL APEX attended the pace from the outside while under wraps and tired after the opening three quarters. WISED UP had no response when roused and tired.
