PERSONABLE PETE argued the pace while between rivals and stayed on to hold the place spot. CAREFREE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. ELECTRA Q SHUN contested the pace while three wide and weakened in the stretch. ASSUMED RISK contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. BARRAGE chased the pace while between rivals and tired. KENTUCKY SQUALL had no rally. EQUINOX raced wide and tired. YANKEE DOODLE BOY had no response when roused. WESTON FIELD chased inside and tired. RESURGENCE was outrun. SPECIAL SAINT tired.
